

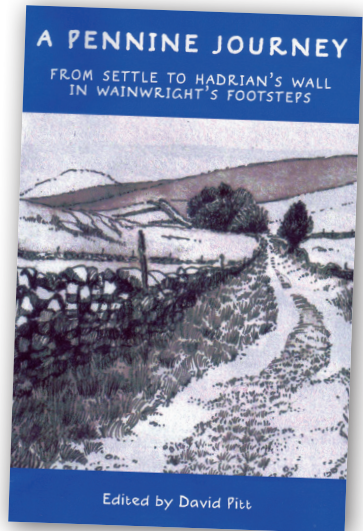
# A Pennine Journey

In September 1938, Alfred Wainwright made a solitary walk through the Pennines. The following year he wrote up an account of this walk, which was eventually published in 1986.

Now, a new pictorial guide, written by members of the Wainwright Society was published in May 2010 by Frances Lincoln Limited and is a recreation of this walk adapted for today's roads and rights-of-way, taking a route that Wainwright might have chosen if he was planning it today. The route is 247 miles long and divided into 18 stages.
